










Introduction

The story of the Duhok Polytechnic University (DPU) can be traced back to the founding of the Duhok Technical Institute (DTI) in 1988. It was the first publicly funded, post-secondary institution in Duhok Governorate to provide application-oriented education. Additionally, DTI played an important role in supporting the establishment of the University of Duhok (UoD) in 1992 and Nawroz University in 2004.

Located at the center of Duhok city, the DTI started with 75 students in two departments only (Surveying and Accounting). In 1989 the number of students increased to 531 with the addition of another two departments (Mechanics and Computer Systems). In order to serve the community at different districts around Duhok city, additional seven Technical Institutes (TI) granting Diploma were established up to 2011, namely Akre TI (2000), Zakho TI (2002), Amedi TI (2003), Shekhan TI (2008), Shingal TI (2009) Bardarash TI (2010) and Duhok Administrative TI (2011).

However, on the 7th of August 2012, the Kurdistan Regional Government (KRG) approved the university status to the seven TIs under the name of Duhok Polytechnic University. In 2013 two Technical Colleges (TC) were established (Engineering and Administration). Recently, in May 2014 Akre TC and TC of Health in Shekhan were approved as well.
